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	DECLARATION OF JANETH	ANTONIO RE: NOTICE PROCEDURES

I, Janeth Antonio, declare and state as follows:

1. I am a Director with Verita formerly known as KCC Class Action Services, LLC ("KCC"), located at 1 McInnis Pkwy, San Rafael, CA 94903. Pursuant to the Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Settlement (the "Preliminary Approval Order") dated May 27, 2025, the Court appointed Verita as the Claims Administrator in connection with the proposed Settlement of the above-captioned Action. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein and, if called upon, could and would testify thereto.

#### **CLASS LIST**

- 2. On June 11, 2025, Verita received from Constangy, Brooks, Smith & Prophete, LLP, a list of 147,118 persons identified as the Class List. The Class List included first names, last names, addresses, and phone numbers. On June 16, 2025, Verita received a replacement list of 147,118 persons, including names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses.
- 3. Verita formatted the list for mailing purposes. There were 446 records with bad, missing, or incomplete addresses. Verita removed 138 duplicate records and processed the names and addresses through the National Change of Address Database ("NCOA") to update any addresses on file with the United States Postal Service ("USPS"). A total of 10,987 addresses were found and updated via NCOA. Verita updated its proprietary database with the Class List.

#### MAILING OF THE NOTICE PACKET

- 4. On June 26, 2025, Verita caused the Postcard Notice (collectively, the "Notice") to be printed and mailed to the 49,403 names and mailing addresses in the Class List. A true and correct copy of the Notice is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 5. Since mailing the Notices to the Class Members, Verita has received 198 Notices returned by the USPS with forwarding addresses. Verita immediately caused Notices to be remailed to the forwarding addresses supplied by the USPS.
- 6. Since mailing the Notices to the Class Members, Verita has received 4,842 Notices returned by the USPS with undeliverable addresses. Through credit bureau and/or other public

source databases, Verita performed address searches for these undeliverable Notices and was able to find updated addresses for 533 Class Members. Verita promptly re-mailed Notices to the updated addresses.

#### **EMAILING OF THE NOTICE PACKET**

- 7. On June 26, 2025, Verita caused the Email Notice to be sent to 97,131 valid email addresses in the Class List. A true and correct copy of the Email Notice is attached as Exhibit B.
- 8. On or around July 8, 2025, Verita received a report from the email vendor confirming that 89,287 emails were sent successfully without a notification of a bounce. There were 7,844 emails that were not successfully delivered.
- 9. On August 1, 2025, Verita caused the Notice to be sent to the 7,838 individuals whose email notice bounced and had a valid mailing address.

#### **PUBLICATION OF THE SUMMARY NOTICE**

10. Verita caused the Summary Notice to be published as an approximate eighth-page ad unit in the June 26, 2025, issue of the *Santa Rosa Press Democrat*, an approximate eighth-page ad unit in the June 27, 2025, issue of *The Petaluma Argus Courier*, and an approximate quarter-page ad unit in the June 30, 2025, issue of the *North Bay Business Journal*. The circulation stats are provided below. Verita also caused the Summary Notice to be distributed as a press release throughout the state of California via PR Newswire on June 26, 2025. The press release resulted in 244 pickups by media outlets and a total potential audience of 76,700,700. These publications were chosen, after discussion with Class Counsel, as a way to ensure notice would reach as much of Marin County as possible, and these publications together cover almost the entirety of Marin County, where Defendant is based and its locations accept patients. True and correct copies of the Summary Notice as it appeared in each publication and as a press release are attached hereto as Exhibit C.

11. Consistent with Rule 3.769 of the California Rules of Court, notice was provided to class members via both direct notice to available class members, as well as press releases issued in the Santa Rosa *Press Democrat*, the *Petaluma Argus-Courier*, and the *North Bay Business Journal* to ensure due process to the Class.

#### **SETTLEMENT WEBSITE**

- 12. On or about May 30, 2025, Verita established a Settlement Website, available at www.marinhealthsettlement.com dedicated to this matter to provide information to the Class Members and to answer frequently asked questions. The Settlement Website URL was set forth in the Notice, Email Notice, Claim Form, and Long Form Notice. Visitors of the Settlement Website can download copies of the Notice, Claim Form, and other case-related documents. True and correct copies of the Claim Form and Long Form Notice are attached hereto as Exhibit D and E.
- 13. As of September 4, 2025, there have been 55,380 users, 61,261 sessions/hits (active visits to the website) and 74,064 page views of the Settlement Website.

#### **TELEPHONE HOTLINE**

- 14. Verita established and continues to maintain a toll-free telephone number 1-833-422-2622 for potential Class Members to call and obtain information about the Settlement or request a Notice Packet. The telephone hotline became operational on June 25, 2025, and is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- 15. As of September 5, 2025, 2025, Verita has received a total of 1,563 calls to the telephone hotline. Verita has mailed 96 Notice Packets to individuals who requested via the telephone hotline.

#### **CLAIM FORMS**

- 16. The postmark deadline for Class Members to file claims in this matter is September 24, 2025. To date, Verita has received 119,623 timely-filed claim forms. Of these claim forms, 10,626 claims were submitted by Class Members who received direct notice and submitted a claim form using their Claim ID and PIN. 108,997 claims were submitted by individuals without a Claim ID and PIN. These 108,997 claims are considered "Unknown" claims. Based on names, address, or email addresses, Verita has been able to match 1,185 Unknown claims to the Class List.
- 17. Verita is working with ClaimScore to determine the validity of Unknown claims. Verita has sent 63,532 claims to ClaimScore to be analyzed. Based on names, addresses, phone numbers, emails, and/or IP addresses, ClaimScore has concluded that 2,144 claims should be approved and 61,388 should be rejected. Verita has also completed an analysis of the 63,532 claims. Verita and ClaimScore agree that 59,383 claims should be rejected as deemed to be fraudulent submissions, and 327 claims should be approved.
- 18. Verita expects additional timely-filed claim forms to arrive up through the filing deadline, and will continue to work with ClaimScore throughout the adjudication process.
- 19. Based on certain assumptions, and the number of valid claims that are submitted to date, the estimated range for a Cash Fund Payment is \$137 and \$86.

#### REPORT ON EXCLUSION REQUESTS RECEIVED TO DATE

20. The Notice informs Class Members that requests for exclusion from the Class must be postmarked no later than August 25, 2025. As of the date of this declaration, Verita has received four (4) requests for exclusion. Based on a class size of 229,000 class members, 0.00175% of the class has requested to be excluded from the settlement. A list of the Class Members requesting to be excluded is attached hereto as Exhibit F.

## **OBJECTIONS TO THE SETTLEMENT** The postmark deadline for Class Members to object to the Settlement was August 21. 25, 2025. As of the date of this declaration, Verita has received two (2) objections to the settlement, which is 0.00087% of the class. A copy of the objections is attached hereto as Exhibit G. ## State offering cannabis research funding

#### SSU's Robert Eyler and the Legacy project qualified previously

By SUSAN WOOD North Bay Business Journal

California cannabis regulators are offering \$30 million in funding earmarked for cannabis research proposals at public universities.

The state Department of Cannabis Control is accepting applications until Aug. 12 for the academic research, now in its third round. The first \$30 million round was scheduled in 2020, while the second \$20 million phase was slated three years later.

Those selected for the third round will be announced in October.

"Since the first round, we've seen improvement in the process narrowed down to a science," state cannabis Deputy Director of Policy Research Jacqueline Campion said.

Topics from the more than 150 already-accepted applicants range from the industry's economic health to documen-

tation of plant genetics.

Robert Eyler, an economics professor for Sonoma State University, completed his study titled "Economic Impact of Cannabis on North Coast County Economies" in the first round. It was commissioned for Humboldt State University based in Arcata.

"It was an intriguing project, a look at an industry in crisis. I went into it naive about all the nooks and crannies in the industry," he said.

The limits of the regulatory environment stood out as a pressing issue with the industry's economic health.

He heard from operators who complained that relief from the cultivation tax, among other concessions made a few years ago, offered "marginal improvement — not a game changer."

This small improvement from the industry's perspective has led to some growers electing to fallow their cannabis fields and others to fold.

"The bottom line is, I think a lot of them feel (more) regulatory reform still needs to happen," he said.

The cultivation community is taking part in another state grant-funded project through UC Berkeley on legacy genetics.

This extensive project titled "Legacy Cannabis Genetics: People and Their Plants, a Community-Driven Study" explores the genetic framework of plants grown by legacy farmers.

The project has produced a website and remains in the community engagement process.

"It's been touching to see people come out for this. We're all trying to survive and reconnect through the passion for the plant," said Genine Coleman, executive director of Origins Council, a legacy

growers advocacy organization helping to spearhead the project. "Through all this, it reminds us of why we got into this."

The \$30 million grant program is funded by cannabis tax revenues established under Proposition 64, which legalized adult-use cannabis in 2016.

Priority cannabis research subjects range from an analysis of crop yields and consumer preferences to educational approaches to public health and the impacts on the human body.

State cannabis regulators indicate projects may explore different factions of the industry, including those that reveal the benefits as well as the risks.

Projects may also cross state lines if the primary applicant is based in California. Oregon, Washington, Colorado and Michigan have active research programs as well. Combining state resources serves to "strengthen relationships between the states," state cannabis regulators explained.

"At a time when the federal government is pulling back funding for cannabis-related research, California is stepping up," state cannabis Director Nicole Elliott said in a statement.

## **Recruiter files for Chapter 11**

CareerBuilder + Monster, a firm that brought together early trailblazers in online job recruiting, filed for bankruptcy protection in Delaware as business continues to shrivel.

The company said Tuesday it started a Chapter 11 process to facilitate a sale of the operations, according to a statement. The firm had estimated liabilities between \$100 and \$500 million, and assets between \$50 and \$100 million, according to its bankruptcy filing.

CareerBuilder and Monster both launched during the 1990s and popularized online job searching just as internet use was going mainstream. Owned by Apollo Global Management, CareerBuilder struggled throughout the Covid-19 pandemic amid a decline in subscription renewals, while a new marketing strategy put pressure on revenue and profit.

In 2023, the company had to extend the maturity of its first-lien loan to 2026. A year later, it amended the terms of the debt to allow for the payment of a part of the interest with more debt.

Eventually, Careerbuilder merged with Monster, with its shareholder Randstad NV taking a minority stake in the combined business, but liquidity remained weak. At the end of June 2024, the company had \$6 million on its balance sheet, S&P Global Ratings said in a report published in October.

The company trimmed its workforce amid ongoing challenges from competition in its job-advertising segment, according to S&P, and the industry is likely to face the impact of AI.

Under the bankruptcy plan, the jobs board business would be sold to JobGet Inc. while Monster Media Properties would be bought by Valnet Inc. Monster Government Services, which provides management software to state and federal governments, would be transferred to Valsoft Corp. These firms are the stalking horse bidders, and the completion of asset sales is subject to higher and better offers.

CareerBuilder + Monster also said it's in talks with Blue Torch Capital for as much as \$20 million of debtor-in-possession financing. A workforce reduction is part of the plan as well, Chief Executive Officer Jeff Furman said in the statement. ## If you used a MarinHealth Medical Center Website between August 1, 2019, and May 27, 2025, then you may be entitled to compensation.

A court authorized this Notice. This is not a solicitation from a lawyer.

A Settlement has been proposed in a class action lawsuit against MarinHealth Medical Center ("Marin" or "Defendant") relating to Marin's alleged use of Meta Pixel on its Websites between August 1, 2019, and May 27, 2025, during which Plaintiffs allege their web usage data, containing Personal Information, was shared with third parties, allegedly resulting in the invasion of Plaintiffs' and Settlement Class Members' privacy.

Marin has denied the allegations.

"Pixel Disclosure" means the alleged disclosure of Plaintiffs' and Settlement Class Members' personal or health information to Facebook, Google, or other third parties as a result of any use of Tracking Pixels on Defendant's websites. The Parties have reached a Settlement to resolve the claims brought in the Action and to provide relief to Settlement Class Members.

You are a Class Member if you visited a MarinHealth Medical Center Website between August 1, 2019, and May 27, 2025 ("Relevant Period").

- Under the Settlement, Marin has agreed to establish a \$3 million Settlement Fund for *pro rata* cash payments to all verified Class Members. The Settlement Fund will also be used to pay for the costs of the settlement administration, Court-approved attorneys' fees, litigation costs and expenses, and Service Payments for Class Representatives. In addition, Marin removed Meta Pixel technology on its websites and will not install Meta Pixel without notice to and consent from the website users.
- Each Class Member may submit a claim either electronically through the Settlement Website or by mail.
- If the amount in the Net Settlement Fund (net of costs of notice and settlement administration, Settlement Class Counsel's attorneys' fees and litigation expenses and the service awards for Plaintiffs) is either less or more than the amount of the total cash claims submitted by Claimants, the claims of each Claimant will be decreased or increased, respectively, *pro rata*, to ensure the Settlement Fund is exhausted, with no reversion from the Settlement Fund to Defendant. #### **BASIC INFORMATION**

#### 1. Why was Notice issued?

A state court authorized Notice because you have the right to know about the proposed Settlement of this class action lawsuit and about all your rights and options before the Court decides whether to grant final approval of the Settlement. This Notice explains the lawsuit, the Settlement, your legal rights, what benefits are available, who is eligible for them, and how to get them.

The Honorable Stephen P. Freccero of the Marin County Superior Court is overseeing this class action. The case is known as *Doe, et al. v. MarinHealth Medical Center*, Case No. CV-000-2218 (Marin County Superior Court) (the "Action"). The people who filed this lawsuit are called the "Plaintiffs" and the company they sued that is a party to this Settlement, MarinHealth Medical Center, is called the "Defendant."

#### 2. What is the lawsuit about?

The lawsuit alleges that between August 1, 2019, and May 27, 2025, Defendant disclosed certain information to a third party without authorization or consent through the Meta Pixel. Plaintiffs allege their web usage data, containing this information was shared with third parties, allegedly resulting in the invasion of Plaintiffs' and Settlement Class Members' privacy, and that they were injured as a result. The Defendant, MarinHealth Medical Center, denies any wrongdoing, and no court or other entity has made any judgment or other determination of any wrongdoing or that the law has been violated. Defendant denies these and all other claims made in the Action. By entering into the Settlement, the Defendant is not admitting that it did anything wrong.

#### 3. Why is this a class action?

In a class action, one or more people called the Class Representatives sue on behalf of all people who have similar claims. Together all these people are called a Class or Class Members. One court resolves the issues for all Class Members, except for those Class Members who exclude themselves from the Class.

The Class Representatives in this case are John Doe I, John Doe II, and John Doe III.

#### 4. Why is there a settlement?

The Class Representatives and Defendant do not agree about the claims made in this Action. The Action has not gone to trial and the Court has not decided in favor of the Class Representatives or Defendant. Instead, the Class Representatives and Defendant have agreed to settle the Action. The Class Representatives and the attorneys for the Class ("Class Counsel") believe the Settlement is best for all Class Members because of the risks and uncertainty associated with continued litigation and the nature of the defenses raised by Defendant.

#### WHO IS IN THE SETTLEMENT?

To see if you are affected or if you can get benefits, you first have to determine whether you are a Settlement Class Member.

#### 5. How do I know if I am part of the Settlement?

If you are a MarinHealth Medical Center patient, California citizen, or other member of the public, who visited Marin's Websites between August 1, 2019, through May 27, 2025, you have been identified by the Settlement Administrator as a Class Member. The Settlement does not include: (1) the Judges presiding over the Actions and members of their families; (2) Marin, its subsidiaries, parent companies, successors, predecessors, and any entity in which Marin or its parents have a controlling interest, and its current or former officers and directors; (3) natural persons who properly execute and submit a Request for Exclusion prior to the expiration of the Opt-Out Period; and (4) the successors or assigns of any such excluded natural person.

#### 6. I'm still not sure if I'm included in the Settlement.

If you are not sure whether you are included in the Class, call 1-833-422-2622 or go to www.MarinHealthSettlement.com.

#### THE SETTLEMENT BENEFITS—WHAT YOU GET

#### 7. What does the Settlement provide?

The Settlement will provide Class Members with *pro rata* Cash Fund Payments in amounts to be determined in accordance with the terms of the Settlement. In addition, Marin has agreed to remove Meta Pixel technology on its websites and will not install Meta Pixel without notice to and consent from the website users as a result of this Action.

To receive a *pro rata* Cash Fund Payment, you must submit a claim. The amount of the Cash Fund Payment will vary depending on the number of valid claims that are submitted. An estimated range for the Cash Fund Payment is \$261 to \$78 (assuming a 3% to 10% claims rate respectively), <u>but these are just estimates</u>, <u>not a guarantee</u>. To receive a Cash Fund Payment, you must submit a completed Claim Form electing to receive a Cash Fund Payment. <u>If you had submitted a Claim prior to the finalization of the Settlement</u>, you will automatically receive a *pro rata* Cash Fund Payment, no additional Claim Form is required.

You are <u>not</u> required to provide supporting documents with your Claim Form to receive a Cash Fund Payment. Individual Cash Fund Payments may be reduced or increased *pro rata* depending on the number of Class Members that participate in the Settlement and the amount of money that remains in the Cash Fund.

Before determining if a Cash Fund Payment is best for you, it is important for you to understand how Settlement Payments will be made. Class Counsel will seek reasonable attorneys' fees not to exceed \$1,000,000, costs not to exceed \$50,000, and Service Payments of \$2,000 to each of the Class Representatives will be deducted from the Settlement Fund before making payments to Class Members. The Court may award less than these amounts. The Settlement Fund will also pay for the reasonable costs associated with providing notice of the Settlement and processing Claim Forms, as well as any applicable taxes. The remainder of the Settlement Fund will be distributed as *pro rata* Cash Fund Payments to individuals who submit a complete Claim Form, which the Settlement Administrator has approved. If you submitted an Approved Claim prior to finalization of this Settlement, you will receive an automatic Cash Fund Payment once the Settlement is approved by the Court and the Effective Date passes, provided you have not requested exclusion from the Settlement (see "Excluding Yourself From The Settlement" below).

The Settlement provides a \$3,000,000 Settlement Fund and remedial actions taken by Marin for the benefit of the Class. Any Court-approved attorneys' fees, costs, and expenses, Service Payments to the Class Representatives, taxes due on any interest earned by the Settlement Fund, if necessary, and any notice and settlement administration expenses will be paid out of the Settlement Fund, and the balance ("Net Settlement Fund") will be used to pay for the above Settlement benefits.

Unless you exclude yourself, you are choosing to remain in the Class. If the Settlement is approved and becomes final, all the Court's orders will apply to you and legally bind you. You will not be able to sue, continue to sue, or be part of any other lawsuit against Marin about the legal issues in this Action, resolved by this Settlement and released by the Class Action Settlement Agreement and Release. The specific rights you are giving up are called Released Claims.

#### 8. What am I giving up in exchange for the Settlement benefits?

If the Settlement becomes final, Class Members will be releasing Defendant and all related people and entities for all the claims described and identified in Section 3.5 of the Settlement Agreement ("Release") and is included below:

The Releasing Parties hereby fully release and forever discharge the Released Parties from any and all of its respective past, present, and future parent companies, partnerships, subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, employees, servants, members, providers, partners, principals, directors, shareholders, and owners, and all of their respective attorneys, heirs, executors, administrators, insures, coinsurers, reinsurers, joint ventures, personal representatives, predecessors, successors, transferees, trustees, and assigns, and includes, without limitation, any Person related to any such entities who is, was, or could have been named as a defendant in the Action, as well as users of Marin's websites whose data may have been shared with third parties by Meta Pixel ("Released Parties") from any and all claims or causes of action of every kind and description, including any causes of action in law, claims in equity, complaints, suits or petitions, and any allegations of wrongdoing, demands for legal, equitable or administrative relief (including, but not limited to, any claims for injunction, rescission, reformation, restitution, disgorgement, constructive trust, declaratory relief, compensatory damages, consequential damages, penalties, exemplary damages, punitive damages, attorneys' fees, costs, interest or expenses) that the Releasing Parties had or could have asserted in the Action (including, but not limited to, assigned claims), or in any other action or proceeding before any court, arbitrator(s), tribunal or administrative body (including but not limited to any state, local or federal regulatory body), regardless of whether the claims or causes of action are based on federal, state, or local law, statute, ordinance, regulation, contract, common law, or any other source, and regardless of whether they are known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, suspected or unsuspected, or fixed or contingent, arising out of, or related or connected in any way with the claims or causes of action of every kind and description that were brought, alleged, argued, raised or asserted in any pleading or court filing in the Action, that arise out of or relate to the causes of action, allegations, practices, or conduct at issue in the Complaint related to Marin, with respect to the use of Meta Pixel ("Released Claims"). The Released Claims

are limited to only those that arose between August 1, 2019, and May 27, 2025. The Release will not be effective for Class Members until 30 Days after the Effective Date.

"Effective Date" means one Business Day following the latest of: (i) the date upon which the time expires for filing or noticing any appeal of the Judgment; (ii) if there is an appeal or appeals, the date of completion, in a manner that finally affirms and leaves in place the Judgment without any material modification, of all proceedings arising out of the appeal(s) (including, but not limited to, the expiration of all deadlines for motions for reconsideration or petitions for review and/or certiorari, all proceedings ordered on remand, and all proceedings arising out of any subsequent appeal(s) following decisions on remand); or (iii) the date of final dismissal of any appeal or the final dismissal of any proceeding on certiorari with respect to the Judgment.

The Released Claims do not include claims relating to the enforcement of the Settlement. Medical malpractice, or other bodily injury claims, are expressly excluded from the release.

Notice of the Court's final judgment will be affected by posting it on the Settlement Administrator's website and by posting a copy of the final judgment and final approval order on the Settlement Administrator's website at www.MarinHealthSettlement.com. The full Settlement Agreement is available at www.MarinHealthSettlement.com. The Settlement Agreement describes the Released Claims with specific descriptions, in necessarily accurate legal terminology, so please read it carefully. The deadline to submit a claim for a Cash Fund Payment is September 24, 2025.

If you submitted medical forms on a Marin Website during the Relevant Period, you will receive an automatic Cash Fund Payment once the Settlement is approved by the Court and the Effective Date passes, provided you have not requested exclusion from the Settlement (see "Excluding Yourself From The Settlement" below).

If you change your mailing address or email address after you submit a Claim Form, it is your responsibility to inform the Settlement Administrator of your updated information. None of the money in the \$3 million Settlement Fund will be paid back to Marin. Any money left in the Settlement Fund after 150 days after the distribution of payments to Class Members will be distributed *pro rata* among all Class Members with approved claims, who cashed or deposited their initial check or received the Settlement proceeds through digital means, as long as the average payment amount is \$3 or more. If there is not enough money to provide qualifying Class Members with an additional \$3 payment, the remaining funds will be distributed to a non-profit organization, or "Non-Profit Residual

Recipient." The Non-Profit Residual Recipient is, subject to final court approval, the Marin Foster Care Association, a 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

#### 10. When will I get my payment?

Payment for valid claims for a Cash Fund Payment will be provided by the Settlement Administrator after the Settlement is approved and becomes final. You may elect to receive payment for valid claims for a Cash Fund Payment digitally (e.g., via PayPal, Venmo) instead of a check, by submitting your claim online at www.MarinHealthSettlement.com. Anyone who does not elect to receive payment digitally will receive their payment via regular check sent through U.S. Mail.

The approval process may take time. Please be patient and check www.MarinHealthSettlement.com for updates.

#### EXCLUDING YOURSELF FROM THE SETTLEMENT

If you want to keep the right to sue or continue to sue Defendant over the legal issues in this case, you must take steps to get out of the Settlement. This is called asking to be excluded from—sometimes called "opting out" of—the Class. If you exclude yourself from the Settlement, you will not be entitled to receive any money from this lawsuit.

#### 11. If I exclude myself, can I get anything from the Settlement?

If you ask to be excluded, you will not get a Cash Award under the Settlement, and you cannot object to the Settlement. But you may be part of a different lawsuit against Defendant in the future. You will not be bound by anything that happens in this lawsuit.

#### 12. If I don't exclude myself, can I sue later?

No. Unless you exclude yourself, you give up the right to sue Defendant for the claims that this Settlement resolves. You must exclude yourself from *this* Class to start or continue your own lawsuit.

#### 13. How do I get out of the Settlement?

To exclude yourself from the Settlement, you must complete and sign a Request for Exclusion. The Request for Exclusion must be postmarked or received by the Settlement Administrator on or before the end of the Opt-Out Period. Requests for Exclusion must be submitted to the Settlement Administrator via U.S. Mail. Requests for Exclusion must be in writing and must identify the case name *Doe, et al. v MarinHealth Medical Center*, No. CV-000-2218 (Marin County Superior Court); state the name, address and telephone number of the Settlement Class Members seeking exclusion; be physically signed by the Person(s) seeking exclusion; and must also contain a statement to the effect that "I/We hereby request to be excluded from the proposed Settlement Class in *Doe, et al. v MarinHealth Medical Center*, No. CV-000-2218 (Marin County Superior Court)." Any Person who elects to request exclusion from the Settlement Class shall not (i) be bound by any orders or Judgment entered in the Action, (ii) be entitled to relief under this Agreement, (iii) gain any rights by virtue of this Agreement, or (iv) be entitled to object to any aspect of this Agreement. No Person may request to be excluded from the Settlement Class through "mass" or "class" opt-outs.

#### **OBJECTING TO THE SETTLEMENT**

#### 14. How do I tell the Court I don't like the proposed Settlement?

You can ask the Court to deny approval by filing an objection. You cannot ask the Court to order a different settlement; the Court can only approve or reject the Settlement. If the Court denies approval, no Settlement Payments will be sent out and the lawsuit will continue. If that is what you want to happen, you must object.

Any objection to the proposed Settlement must be in writing. Objections must be served via United States Mail or email to the Settlement Administrator, whose contact information is provided in Ouestion 22 below.

You objection must include the following:

- (i) your full name, current mailing address, and telephone number;
- (ii) a signed statement that you believe yourself to be a member of the Settlement Class;
- (iii) whether the objection applies only to the you as the objector, a subset of the Settlement Class, or the entire Settlement Class;
- (iv) the specific grounds for your objection;
- (v) all documents or writings that you desire the Court to consider; and
- (vi) a statement regarding whether you (or counsel of your choosing) intend to appear at the Fairness Hearing.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, you may be allowed to speak regarding your objection at the Fairness Hearing, even if you have not complied with these procedures, subject to the discretion of the presiding Judge.

The Court may only require substantial compliance with the requirements for submitting an objection. The requirement to submit a written objection may be waived upon a showing of good cause.

#### **OBJECTION AND OPT-OUT DIFFERENCES**

#### 15. What is the difference between objecting and opting out?

Objecting is telling the Court you do not like something about the Settlement. You can object only if you stay in the Class (that is, do not exclude yourself). Requesting exclusion is telling the Court you do not want to be part of the Class or the Settlement. If you exclude yourself, you cannot object to the Settlement because it no longer affects you. If you do not request exclusion, you may, if you so desire, enter an appearance through counsel.

#### THE LAWYERS REPRESENTING YOU

#### 16. Do I have a lawyer in the case?

The Court has designated Ryan Clarkson, Yana Hart and Bryan P. Thompson of Clarkson Law Firm and Matthew J. Langley of Almeida Law Group to represent you as "Class Counsel." You will not be charged for these lawyers. If you want to be represented by another lawyer, you may hire one to appear in Court for you at your own expense.

#### 17. How will the costs of the lawsuit and Settlement be paid?

The Settlement Administrator's and Notice Provider's costs and fees associated with administering the Settlement, including all costs associated with the publication of the Notice of Settlement will be paid out of the Settlement Fund. Class Counsel's reasonable attorneys' fees and costs related to obtaining the Settlement consistent with applicable law will also be paid out of the Settlement Fund, subject to Court approval.

The three Class Representatives will also request that the Court approve a payment to them of up to \$2,000 total from the Settlement Fund, as service awards for their participation as the Class Representatives, for taking on the risk of litigation, and for settlement of their individual claims as Class Members in the settled Actions. The amounts are subject to Court approval and the Court may award less.

#### THE COURT'S FAIRNESS HEARING

The Court will hold a hearing to decide whether to approve the Settlement. If you have filed an objection on time, you may attend and you may ask to speak, but you don't have to.

#### 18. When and where will the Court decide whether to approve the Settlement?

The Court will hold a Fairness Hearing at 1:30 p.m. on **October 20, 2025**, before the Honorable Stephen P. Freccero in Courtroom A of the Marin County Superior Court, located at 3501 Civic Center, Vera Schultz Drive, San Rafael, CA 94903. The hearing may be moved to a different date or time without additional notice, so please check for updates at www.MarinHealthSettlement.com. At this hearing, the Court will consider whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate. If there are objections, the Court will consider them. In order to speak at the Fairness Hearing, you must file a notice of intention to appear with the Clerk. The Court will also decide how much to pay the Class Representatives and the lawyers representing Class Members. After the hearing, the Court will decide whether to approve the Settlement. We do not know how long these decisions will take.

#### 19. Do I have to come to the hearing?

No. Class Counsel will answer any questions the judge may have. But you are welcome to come at your own expense. If you send an objection, you don't have to come to Court to talk about it. As long as you mailed your written objection on time, the Court will consider it. If you have sent an objection but do not come to the Court hearing, however, you will not have a right to appeal an approval of the Settlement. You may also pay another lawyer to attend on your behalf, but it's not required.

#### 20. May I speak at the hearing?

Yes. If you wish to attend and speak at the Fairness Hearing, you should indicate this in your written objection (see Question 14 above). If you plan to have your attorney speak for you at the Fairness Hearing, your objection should also include your attorney's name, address, and phone number.

#### IF YOU DO NOTHING

#### 21. What happens if I do nothing at all?

If you are a Class Member and do nothing, you will not receive a payment from this Settlement. And, unless you exclude yourself, you won't be able to start a lawsuit, continue with a lawsuit, or be part of any other lawsuit against Defendant about the claims in this case, ever again.
